Abingdon Bridge	Loose Cannon	4.1	Amber (Best Bitter)	Copper coloured, traditional 'bitter'. It kicks off with a good bitter bite, followed by plenty of flavour. A full and satisfying roundness.
Beauty and the Yeast	Loose Cannon	4.4	Amber (Best Bitter)	Fruity and refreshing.
Brew 58 IPA	Brew 58	3.6	Golden	American style IPA, packed with hop flavour, from a micro micro brewery in Wallingford.
Broken Dream Breakfast Stout	Sirencraft	6.5	Dark (Stout)	Broken Dream is deep and complex. She lurks in your imagination. She binds smoke and coffee aromas with chocolate, milk and oats to create something thick, velvety and slick.
Conqueror Black IPA	Windsor and Eton	5.0	Dark	Conqueror is a rich, complex and very distinctive ale. Packed with 5 speciality malts for a wonderful combination of roasted flavours and unlike a stout, this beer packs a mighty punch of flavour derived from Summit and Cascade hops.
Dark & Seedy	Little Ox	5.6	Dark (Stout)	A smooth and well rounded Vanilla stout.
Doctor Roo	Love Beer	3.7	Golden	Golden pale ale, double citra hopped, with light citrus flavours.
English Bitter	Stardust	4.0	Amber (Best Bitter)	This beer is blended to bring out the very best of traditional British malt and hop flavours. The raised malt profile unlocks notes of roasted caramel, which mingle with classic hop aromas.
Ferryman's Gold	Loddon	4.2	Golden	Brewed using Slovenian Stryian Golding hops, which impart a zesty Lime flavour. The mix of Cara malt and Wheat malt give a smooth, creamy body to the beer.
Forbury Lion	Loddon	5.5	Amber (Strong)	An IPA as an IPA should be: packed with a full malty flavour and a strong complex hop finish imparted by Styrian Goldings and Fuggles hops.
Good Old Boy	West Berks	4.0	Amber (Best Bitter)	A good balance of malt and hops giving a full-bodied bitter with strong malt flavours, yet retaining a rounded bitterness and a strong hop finish.
Hoppit	Loddon	3.5	Amber (Bitter)	The predominant hops in Hoppit are East Kent Goldings which traditionally have a Seville Orange marmalade flavour. As well as Pale Ale malt, Hoppit also contains dark Invert Sugar which gives the beer its smooth taste. This is an excellent fairly bitter session ale.
Knight of the Garter	Windsor and Eton	3.8	Golden	A straw coloured golden ale with an initial hit of cut grapefruit zest giving way to a deliciously sharp sherbet finish.
Little Jester	Stardust	3.6	Amber (Bitter)	Using the one and only UK Jester hop this beer has a delicate fruitiness on the nose, a depth through the middle and leaves a gentle bitterness on the aftertaste. Little in ABV but the Jester is not to be underestimated!
Magg's Magnificent Mild	West Berks	3.8	Dark (Mild)	A typical dark mild with a slightly higher hop rate than normally used in milds. Not too sweet and very popular.
Maharaja IPA	West Berks	5.0	Golden (Strong)	Brewed strong and hoppy, Maharaja is a stunning example of an IPA. Masses of English hops and three different malts produce a complex flavour and strong citrus aroma. Smooth, deep golden and beautifully balanced with a crisp dry finish.
Mr Chubb's Lunchtime Bitter	West Berks	3.7	Amber (Bitter)	A traditional style beer with all English hops and a good bitterness balanced by Maris Otter malts from Wiltshire and Suffolk.

OG Extra Pale Ale	Love Beer		Golden	A really light and refreshing extra pale ale made using english malted barley and a couple of late whole hops. A tropical fruits or cut grass aroma with the taste of citrus and possibly hints of tangerine or rose.
Oxfordshire Bitter	White Horse	3.7	Golden	This golden bitter balances locally grown Challenger Hops with Yorkshire's malt, to offer the discerning drinker a beer that will stop any horse in its tracks.
Ridgeway Bitter	Ridgeway	4.0	Amber (Best Bitter)	Classic best bitter with plenty of hop flavour.
Ridgeway IPA	Ridgeway	5.4	Amber (Best Bitter)	A traditional IPA, high in strength as an IPA should be.
Road Runner	Little Ox	3.9	Golden (Strong)	A beautiful bitter amber ale with a nice hoppy finish. Brewed with UK and New Zealand hops.
Roundhead Bitter	Two Cocks	4.2	Amber (Bitter)	A full-bodied, down to earth, smooth best bitter.
Stay Jammy	Amwell Springs	3.8	Amber (Best Bitter)	Stay Jammy has charisma and charm in abundance. Our traditional English ale has a soft sweetness from it's delicate blend of malts; with mint and berry hops bursting through, this beer is timeless.
Summer Sessions	Oxbrew	3.2	Amber (Bitter)	A super refreshing and light ale with loads of flavour.
Twyford Tipple	Bingham's	3.7	Golden	An easy drinking tawny coloured bitter which has a satisfying malty flavour with a citrus hop finish. Deliciously satisfying despite its lower alcoholic strength. The citrus hops give a refreshing, thirst quenching finish.
Village Idiot	White Horse	4.1	Amber (Bitter)	A beer well hopped with Challenger/Bramling cross hops with a base of fine pale malt and wheat gives a light straw coloured beer with a lasting fruity aftertaste.
Yulu Pale Ale	Sirencraft	3.6	Golden	Yulu is an intricate beer with layers of flavour that remain distinctive, yet work in perfect harmony. Her name alludes to the mystical history of the humble tea leaf, which delivers subtle bergamot orange and lemon notes here, accentuated by the addition of lemon zest. Her delicate hop high notes will leave your taste buds sparkling. Allergens: Malted Barley, Wheat.

Blackberry	Tutt's Clump	4.0	Medium/Sweet	This bottle conditioned Proper Cider is lovingly crafted from a blend of apples before being infused with real blackberry juice
Farmhouse Perry	Tutt's Clump	6.5	Medium/Dry	Handmade from a variety of pears, mainly from within West Berkshire.
Medium-Dry	Red Dog	6.5	Medium/Dry	A still cider with a clear amber colour. It is made locally mainly using unwanted apples from in and around Wallingford. These are blended with dabinett cider apples to give it a distinctive flavour.
Royal Berkshire Sweet	Tutt's Clump	6.0	Sweet	A crisp sweet cider.
Special Reserve Dry	Tutt's Clump	6.0	Dry	A crisp, refreshing, eastern counties style dry cider.
